On the second day of July, I learned I had been exposed to the Coronavirus. I start showing symptoms and was found to be positive. I was quarantined alone at home for several weeks. I am so thankful for all the encouraging phone calls, text messages, and prayers as I was laid up. I thank God that it was only a mild case of the virus. Once my symptoms subsided, I returned to the doctor to ensure I was better. They told me that my heart and my lungs were not affected. I had the blood test done to confirm that I am free of the virus. I learned that I no longer have the virus and that my body made enough antibodies making me immune to the virus. Please continue pray for me as I return to traveling on deputation this month.

The Heavenly Bible Baptist members have found renewing and encouragement in the Lord during this time of fear. Even though I am halfway around the world, I am thankful for the many ways I can continue to have a relationship with my fellow laborers in the Philippines. I mentioned in my last prayer letter that much of the Philippines have been released from a strict lockdown on June 1st. They were able to meet in person for church once again. I have been tuning in to their services before I go to bed each week. My favorite part is hearing them worship the Lord through singing. Even though their voices are muffled by masks, it brings me great joy to hear them worshipping the Lord. It makes me yearn to be there with them even more. The Heavenly Bible Baptist church started live streamed Bible lessons each week for their children's ministry. They are also continuing their weekly Bible reading challenges. It has been such an encouragement to be a part of these challenges. Please pray for the Philippines. Pray for the ministry of Heavenly Bible Baptist Church. Pray for the Ocampo's and their fellow laborers as they continue to minister during these difficult times. They informed me that as of August 3rd, they will be returning to a very strict lockdown due to the increased numbers of virus cases. Please pray that they will be continually renewed and encouraged while they are ministering.

I have found security in the Lord during this time of uncertainty. August marks my one-year anniversary of being accepted by Baptist International Outreach as a missionary to the Philippines. The Lord has showed me many things over the past year. He has been teaching me that no matter how uncertain these times are, He will always take care of His children. The Lord has taken care of me financially, spiritually, and physically. He has never failed me over the last year. I can rest in the hope that He will provide the right churches and individuals that will support me financially and be my prayer partners. I am currently at 25% of my support. Thank you to all my supporters who have been giving faithfully during this difficult time. My goal is to return to the Philippines by the end of March 2021. Please pray that the Lord will lead me to the financial supporters and prayer partners that He has for me.
