God has opened the door to my field! Thank you everyone that has been praying for God to make a way for me to get into the Philippines. As you all know from previous prayer letters, I have been trying to get documents to apply for a visa in order to enter the country. As BIO Philippines and my dad and I continued to search for answers, God opened a door. When God opens the door, you walk through it. Though, it was not open the way I had hoped, the Lord has blessed. On January 28, the embassy informed my dad that the Philippines was going to be opening on February 10, 2022 for tourist travel if the person entering the Philippines is fully vaccinated. When the vaccines first rolled out, I prayed for wisdom. With all the unknown effects of the vaccine, I chose not to get the vaccine. I told the Lord that if the vaccine is mandatory to enter the Philippines, I will know that He wants me to get it because I know the Lord has called me to the Philippines. That is the door God chose to open. On February 1, after much research and counsel from several wise men and women, I received my first vaccine. I will be receiving the second shot on March 1. Due to having to be fully vaccinated (I will be consider fully vaccinated on March 15), I have rescheduled my departure for March 21, 2022. Thank you for your prayers. Please continue to pray for me as I finish preparing to depart for the Philippines. In preparation for leaving, I have packed my last few books and will ship them this month. I will be meeting with BIO to go over a checklist of things to be done before I leave and after I arrive.

God has opened the door to minister! My last deputation meeting was on January 26. I thought that was going to be my last time to share my testimony in a formal setting, but God opened one more opportunity. I will be speaking to a mission class for ladies at Crown College on February 23. I am looking forward to this opportunity and praying that God will use my testimony to encourage more ladies for missions. Now that my deputation traveling has come to an end, it has been so nice to be at my sending church and to serve where I can until my departure.

God has opened the door to gather with friends and family! On February 27, at 6 o'clock in the evening, my commissioning service will take place at my sending church, Faith Baptist Church.
