April has been a whirlwind month. The month started out with family time during Easter weekend; then I hit the deputation trail. My travels took me to Florida for almost two weeks. The churches I visited in Titusville, Arcadia, and Punta Gorda encouraged me greatly. I spoke in four church services, one Wednesday youth meeting, and one chapel service. This trip alone was just over 2,000 miles. For the last two Sundays in April, I had the privilege to present in two other churches close to home (Maynardville and Morristown, Tennessee). I am thankful my Lord continues to use me (an ordinary person) to bless and encourage His people as I travel. I want to thank each of you that earnestly pray for my safety and provision while on the road. The Lord truly answered your prayers.

Returning home from Florida, I traveled by way of Pensacola. I nearly had a serious accident three times. The Lord protected me through your prayers. First, I nearly hit a man leisurely walking across a four-lane highway in the dark with no reflective clothing. Thankfully he was wearing a white shirt. I was able to brake and swerve around him just in time. Second, in pitch black, I was surprised by a half-dozen deer in the middle of the highway. I had just changed lanes a few yards before I saw them. Third, a motorcyclist cut between me and a tractor trailer while I was trying to pass. I was able to brake in time for him to barely make it between us. He was inches from the front of my car. Thank you! God is answering your prayers for safety!

In a previous prayer letter, I mentioned that my only debt was my car. Over the past few months the Lord has abundantly met my needs with surplus. Through this surplus, I have paid off my car. I officially “owe no man any thing.” (Romans 13:8) God has answered your prayers for provision.

The Philippines is still on a strict lockdown, but Heavenly Bible Baptist is doing all they can to keep their ministries going. They are having online services and Bible studies. They are inviting the regulated amount of people to come and be in person at their services. Several of the young pastors are to going member’s homes and conducting Bible studies with limited people. Please continue to pray for Heavenly Bible Baptist Church as they press on during this difficult time. Many of my friends are becoming discouraged. This causes me to yearn even more to be there with them. God is answering your prayers for the Filipino people.

- Pray that the Philippines will open for foreign travel and for restrictions to be lifted.
- Pray for more prayer partners and financial support. I am still at 64%.
- Pray for travel mercies. May is full of church meetings in VA, FL, and AL.
