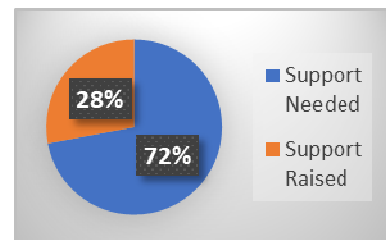

Prayer is more important to me. Without people praying on my behalf I would not be where I am today. Please pray for me as I adjust to living in a new place. Pray for safety as I travel this month. Pray that God will continue to lead me and teach me during this time of waiting, traveling, ministering, and preparing.
